

Sale of Surplus Goods by Online Auction

As goods are declared surplus to the needs of Northumberland County, depending on the nature of the item, it may be posted for sale utilizing the public online auction site GovDeals. The site is user friendly and once an account has been created on their website, you will have access to not only surplus items in Northumberland County, but to all surplus items that GovDeals has for auction on their website.

In general, items are described and accompanied by a photograph on the auction website. The items are sold "As is, where is" meaning that it is the bidder's sole responsibility to satisfy themselves as to the condition and specifications of the goods being offered for sale before placing a bid. Please note that by placing a bid, you are making a contract between yourself and the seller. Once you place a bid, you may not retract it.

If you win an auction, all payments are made online to GovDeals. HST and a buyer's premium will be added to the price of the winning bid. You must pay for the item within 5 business days of the auction ending and make arrangements to pick up the item within 10 business days.

The website is run by GovDeals, but items remain in Northumberland County during the auction and are available for inspection while the items are up for auction. Some items may have a reserve bid (minimum price). If the reserve bid is not met, the County reserves the right to withdraw the offer to sell. At any time prior to the auction closing, Northumberland County reserves the right to suspend or cancel the offer to sell the posted item.
