**Presentation from Kate Hall, Vidya Sunil, HKPR District Health Unit
Situational Assessment of the Four Pillar Approach to Addressing the
Drug Poisoning Crisis**

Haliburton Kawartha Pine Ridge Health Unit Health Promoter Kate Hall, Epidemiologist Vidya Sunil along with Port Hope Police Chief Tim Farquharson presented to Board Members the Situational Assessment of the Four Pillar Approach to Addressing the Drug Poisoning Crisis.

The purpose of the report is to provide a situational assessment of local trends in drug use and poisoning and the four-pillar approach used to address the crisis in the County of Haliburton, City of Kawartha Lakes and Northumberland County.

Board Members were advised that in 2021 there were 50 drug poisoning deaths in the Health Unit Region. 20 of these deaths occurred in Northumberland County. In 2023 there were 36 drug poisoning deaths. Fentanyl was present in 86.1% (31/36) of the opioid related deaths that occurred within the Health Unit. There were 205 opioid related deaths from 2017 – 2023 within the HKPR district

The 4 Pillar Approach to addressing the Drug Poisoning Crisis are:

1. Prevention and Education

Investing in programs that support families and address youth mental health is critical to reduce the risk of substance use disorders in adulthood.

2. Treatment

Comprehensive integrated treatment programs are required. This includes physicians, nurses, nurse practitioners, therapists, pharmacists, and connections to social services and harm reduction.

3. Harm Reduction

A range of harm reduction programs and services are needed to address the risks of drug poisoning. Harm reduction can be a pathway to healthcare and social services.

4. Community Safety

Policing associations provincially recognize substance use disorder as a public health issue, requiring diversion responses that are evidence-based and health-centered.

Kate Hall advised Board Members that her team would be willing to present this report to Municipalities.
