








Property Crime

Matters of Interest – Northumberland OPP Police Services Board

August 2024

ALNWICK/HALDIMAND:

On August 23, 2024, at approximately 10:05 p.m., police responded to a report from a member of the public regarding a driver that had lost control and collided with a ditch in the vicinity of County Road 2 and Hilltop Road in the Township of Alnwick-Haldimand.

Officers arrived at the location and observed a passenger vehicle in the ditch with minimal damage. Following speaking to the uninjured driver, police entered into an impaired operation investigation. The individual was arrested and transported to a local detachment where the accused refused to comply with a demand for breath.

As a result a 30-year-old, from the Township of Alnwick-Haldimand, has been charged with:

- Operation while impaired – alcohol and drugs
- Failure or refusal to comply with demand
- Use plate not authorised for vehicle
- Drive motor vehicle no licence.

BRIGHTON:

On June 30, 2023, OPP recorded a complaint relating to a fraud which occurred at a residential property on Old Wooler Road in the Municipality of Brighton.

The complainant advised that towards the end of October 2022, \$30,000 was paid to the contractor to complete work at the location. However, the individual discontinued, left existing renovations unfinished and their whereabouts was unknown to the caller.

Efforts to resolve were undertaken by the victim prior to making a report to police.

An investigation was initiated where a person was identified and a warrant was sought for their arrest.

As a result, on August 27, 2024, officers arrested the individual wanted in connection with the incident.

A 30-year-old from St. Catherines, has been charged with:

- Fraud over \$5,000

The Northumberland Detachment of the Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) is currently investigating a sudden death in the Municipality of Brighton.

On August 20, 2024, at approximately 8:45 a.m., Emergency Medical Services and members of Northumberland OPP received a call for an unresponsive person in a

residence on Chapel Street in the Municipality of Brighton. The patient was declared deceased a short time later.

The Northumberland OPP Crime Unit is continuing the investigation with assistance from Forensic Identification Services (FIS), in conjunction with the Office of the Chief Coroner and the Ontario Forensic Pathology Service.

The deceased is a 45-year-old from Roseneath and at this time, the death is not considered suspicious.

CRAMAHE:

On August 16, 2024, police received a complaint regarding an assault that took place the previous evening on King Street East in the Township of Cramahe. Injuries to the victim were described as minor.

On August 24, 2024, officers arrested an individual as a result of the investigation. a 37-year-old, Municipality of Brighton resident, has been charged with:

- Assault – two counts.

HAMILTON:

On August 26, 2024, shortly after 8:00 p.m., police responded to a call for service regarding a dispute at a residence in Hamilton Township. Officers arrived and Emergency Medical Services (EMS) were further called to the location by police. The victim had sustained minor injuries and was transported to a local hospital for treatment.

The accused had left prior to the arrival of OPP but returned in the early hours of August 27, 2024, when they was arrested and taken into custody. During the arrest, the individual spat at police. There were no injuries to officers.

A 15-year-old, from the Township of Hamilton, has been charged with:

- Assault
- Assault peace officer

PORT HOPE:

On August 30, 2024, police received a report of a domestic dispute in progress. Officers arrived on scene and arrested a 40-year-old Port Hope resident with the following charges:

- Assault with a weapon – spousal
- Mischief

TRENT HILLS:

The Northumberland Detachment of the Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) has charged an individual with firearm offences in the Municipality of Trent Hills.

On August 21, 2024, shortly after 10:20 p.m., members from Northumberland OPP were dispatched to a disturbance at a residence in the area of 1st Line East. Information was received that an individual was in possession of a weapon, and there were safety concerns for another individual at the residence.

Northumberland OPP officers responded and confirmed the safety of other individual. Police increased their presence by dispatching members of the OPP Tactics and Rescue Unit (TRU) and Emergency Response Team (ERT) to contain the area. There was no threat to public safety.

On August 22, 2024, at approximately 2:15 a.m., the individual was located at a separate address in the area and taken into custody without incident.

As a result of the investigation, the following items were seized:

- Handguns
- Rifles
- Shotgun
- Ammunition

The accused has been charged with:

- Pointing a firearm
- Careless use of firearm
- Possession of weapon for dangerous purpose
