**Motor Vehicle Collisions by Type**



## **Matters of Interest – Northumberland OPP Police Services Board**

**July 2024**

### **ALNWICK/HALDIMAND:**

On July 9, 2024, at approximately 9:30 p.m., police responded to a report of a vehicle in the ditch in the vicinity of Rolling Banks Road and Robins Road in Alnwick-Haldimand Township.

Officers arrived and began an investigation into the cause of the collision and subsequently arrested the driver. The individual was transported to a local detachment for further testing. There were no injuries reported.

A 64-year-old, from Oshawa, has been charged with:

- Operation while impaired – alcohol and drugs
- Operation while impaired – blood alcohol concentration (80 plus)
- Have care or control of vehicle or boat with cannabis in open baggage

### **BRIGHTON:**

On April 12, 2024, Northumberland OPP received information about a sexual assault that had occurred at a residence in the Municipality of Brighton.

As a result of the investigation assisted by the Northumberland Crime Unit, police arrested a person on July 10, 2024. The individual will not be named to protect the identity of the victim.

A 29-year-old male, from Belleville, has been charged with:

- Sexual interference
- Sexual assault on a person under 16 years of age
- Fail to comply with probation order.

### **CRAMAHE:**

On July 1, 2024, shortly after 2:00 p.m., OPP responded to a traffic complaint regarding a vehicle travelling on County Road 25 in the Township of Cramahe. The vehicle was located and stopped by police. The driver was arrested for impaired operation and transported to a local detachment to undergo tests conducted by a Drug Recognition Evaluator (DRE).

A 33-year-old, from the Township of Cramahe, has been charged with:

- Operation while impaired – alcohol and drugs
- Possession of a Schedule I substance – Cocaine.

### **HAMILTON:**

On July 2, 2024, at approximately 6:40 a.m., OPP responded to a dispute at a residence in Hamilton Township. Police arrived at the location and the subject of the complaint was also a male that was sought in connection to an incident of mischief which occurred on May 19, 2024, in the Municipality of Port Hope.

A 33-year-old, of no fixed address was arrested and charged with:

- Mischief – destroys or damages property
- Fail to comply with probation order
- Unlawfully in a dwelling house
- Possession of a Schedule I substance – Cocaine
- Theft under \$5,000.

### **PORT HOPE:**

On July 8, 2024, shortly before 2:00 a.m., an officer was conducting speed enforcement on Highway 401 eastbound in the Municipality of Port Hope when a motor vehicle was observed travelling at 152 km/h in a posted 100 km/h limit. The vehicle briefly stopped for police before taking off and exiting the highway. An investigation commenced and on July 12, 2024, the OPP arrested an individual in relation to the incident.

A 28-year-old, from Milton, has been charged with:

- Drive motor vehicle – perform stunt – excessive speed
- Obstruct peace officer
- Flight from peace officer
- Dangerous Operation.

### **TRENT HILLS:**

On July 8, 2024, at approximately 3:00 a.m., police responded to a report of a Remotely Piloted Aerial System (RPAS) at the Warkworth Institution. Officers patrolled the area and stopped a vehicle nearby on County Road 29. Officers investigated, and the driver was arrested.

A 43-year-old, from Ottawa, has been charged with:

- Mischief – obstructs, interrupts or interferes with the lawful use, enjoyment or operation of property
- Conspiracy to commit summary conviction offence.






### Top 10 Offences by Number of Offence Notices Issued




### Top 10 Offences by Number of Part I Summons Issued
