

Matters of Interest – Northumberland OPP Police Services Board

November 2024

ALNWICK/HALDIMAND:

On November 30, 2024, at approximately 9:00 a.m., police responded to a report from Emergency Medical Services (EMS) regarding a driver who appeared to be experiencing medical issues on the side of County Road 45 in the Township of Alnwick/Haldimand.

Officers arrived and were led into an impaired operation investigation where an Approved Screening Device (ASD) demand was made. The driver complied and provided a sample of their breath resulting in a 'Fail' at which point they were arrested.

A 49 year old from Norwood, has been charged with:

- Operation while impaired – alcohol and drugs
- Operation while impaired – blood alcohol concentration (80 plus)
- Driver vehicle or boat with cannabis readily available.

On November 18, 2024, shortly after 2:00 a.m., police received a report regarding harassment involving two persons.

Through investigative avenues, one of the individuals was found to have provided a false statement.

On December 5, 2024, as a result of the investigation, Alexandra COLEMAN (age 32) from the Township of Alnwick/Haldimand, has been charged with public mischief, and is scheduled to appear before the Ontario Court of Justice in Cobourg at a future date

BRIGHTON:

Several complaints were reported to police regarding a suspicious person attempting to gain access to vehicles between Ontario Street and Center Street early in the afternoon of September 8, 2024. Officers confirmed a theft had occurred upon arrival and a further incident was reported later that day where items were stolen from another vehicle in the same area.

Among the items stolen was a method of payment used to complete a transaction at a local convenience store on the same day. The OPP were looking to identify individuals sought in connection with the investigation.

On November 2, 2024, police arrested one of the persons involved in the incident.

A 36 year old from Trenton, was charged with:

- Theft under \$5,000 from a motor vehicle – two counts
- Use of credit card in the commission of an offence
- Identity theft – obtain or possess another persons identity information

On December 4, 2024, officers arrested the other individual involved.

As a result, a 46 year old from Port Hope, has been charged with:

- Possession of property obtained by crime under \$5,000

CRAMAHE:

On November 13, 2024, shortly after 1:00 p.m., the Northumberland OPP were called to a residence on Mitchell Road in relation to a dropped 9-1-1 call. One person was transported to the hospital with serious injuries.

Investigators believe this was an isolated incident and there was no threat to public safety.

As a result of the initial investigation, one individual was arrested and charged on November 14, 2024.

On November 28, 2024, members from the OPP Repeat Offender Parole Enforcement located and arrested a second individual in Ottawa who was wanted in relation to the incident. The accused was then transported to a detachment in Northumberland.

A 41 year old from Ottawa, has been charged with the following *Criminal Code* offences:

- Aggravated assault, section 268
- Pointing a firearm, section 87

HAMILTON:

On November 23, 2024, police responded to a report regarding the theft of a number of firearms from an address in the Township of Hamilton. The complainant believed the weapons to have been stolen in the previous two weeks. The majority of the

firearms were recovered however among the unaccounted firearms, were shotguns and rifles.

OPP began an investigation and on November 24, 2024, officers made an arrest in relation to the incident of theft.

A 32 year old from Hamilton Township, has been charged with:

- Unauthorized possession of a firearm – 14 counts
- Possession of a weapon obtained by crime – 14 counts
- Possession for the purpose of weapons trafficking
- Transfer a firearm without authority
- Knowledge of unauthorized possession of a firearm
- Theft over \$5,000.

On November 24, 2024, at around 11:00 p.m., officers assisted by the Community Street Crime Unit (CSCU), Emergency Response Team (ERT) and the Tactics and Rescue Unit (TRU), executed a search warrant at a location on John Street in the Town of Cobourg.

Among the items seized, were rifles, shotguns, ammunition, a cellphone and approximately 17 grams of suspected Fentanyl with a street value of around \$3,000.

As a result of the search, one individual was arrested and taken into custody.

A 46 year old has been charged with:

- Unauthorized possession of a firearm – 14 counts
- Possession of a weapon obtained by crime – 14 counts
- Possession of a firearm contrary to a prohibition order
- Knowledge of unauthorised possession of a firearm
- Transfer firearm without authority
- Breach of firearms regulation – store firearm or restricted weapon
- Traffick in Schedule I Substance – Fentanyl.

On November 3, 2024, at approximately 3:25 a.m., an officer located a pickup truck facing the wrong way at the on ramp leading to Highway 401 eastbound in the Township of Hamilton. Police entered into an impaired operation investigation and an ASD demand was made. With the result, the accused was arrested and transported to a local detachment for further tests.

A 25 year old from the Township of Hamilton, has been charged with:

- Operation while impaired – blood alcohol concentration (80) plus

In addition to a future court date, a further 90-day Administrative Driver Licence Suspension (ADLS) and a seven-day vehicle impound was initiated as per statute

PORT HOPE:

On November 6, 2024, at approximately 3:35 a.m., police were on patrol on Wesleyville Road in the Municipality of Port Hope when they observed a passenger vehicle towing a trailer with no light. The officer attempted to stop the vehicle, but the driver fled southbound.

OPP patrolled the local areas and located the motor vehicle which had collided with an overpass in the area of Lakeshore Road and Baulch Road. The driver was then observed fleeing into nearby private fields. There were no other persons involved. Following investigation and identification of the vehicle, officers were made aware that it was recently stolen from an address in Whitby.

The individual was not located during the initial search of the area. The Durham Regional Police Service and Port Hope Police Service were informed of the incident. In the early hours of November 7, 2024, Port Hope Police contacted Northumberland OPP to inform that the person sought in connection with the incident had been located and the accused was taken into custody.

As a result, a 29-year-old, from Courtice, has been charged with:

- Possession of property obtained by crime over \$5,000
- Flight from peace officer
- Dangerous operation
- Failure to stop after accident
- Fail to report damage to fence bordering highway
- Drive motor vehicle – perform stunt
- Draw trailer, no plate
- No red light on rear of trailer
- Enter premises when entry prohibited.

On November 2, 2024, shortly before 11:00 a.m., OPP were conducting speed enforcement on Highway 401 eastbound in the Municipality of Port Hope. An officer observed a pickup truck travelling at a speed of 153 Km/h.

The vehicle was stopped, and an officer utilised Mandatory Alcohol Screening (MAS) by making a demand for breath into an Approved Screening Device (ASD). The driver complied and as a result, the individual was arrested and transported to a local detachment for further tests.

A 26 year old from Clarington, has been charged with:

- Operation while impaired – blood alcohol concentration (80) plus
- Drive motor vehicle – perform stunt – excessive speed.

The accused is scheduled to appear before the Ontario Court of Justice in Cobourg at a future date. The 90-day ADLS was initiated along with a 14-day vehicle impound.

TRENT HILLS:

November 1, 2024, at approximately 8:00 a.m., the Municipality of Trent Hills Fire Department, Emergency Medical Services (EMS) and police responded to a report of a passenger vehicle in the ditch on 12th Line East. Officers arrived on the scene and the motorist was being assessed by EMS for minor injuries. There were no other persons involved and the vehicle had minimal damage.

Through investigation, the driver was found to be suspended from driving and warrants existed for their arrest. An unsealed container of liquor was observed in the vehicle and a search revealed 7.5 grams of Cocaine with a street value of approximately \$670. Small plastic bags, a scale and \$1385 in Canadian currency were also located and seized.

As a result, a 42 year old from Campbellford, was arrested and charged with:

- Possession of a Schedule I substance for the purpose of trafficking – Cocaine
- Fail to comply with probation order
- Driving while under suspension
- Driving motor vehicle with liquor readily available.

Matters of Interest – Northumberland OPP Police Services Board

December 2024

ALNWICK/HALDIMAND:

On December 13, 2024, shortly before 3:50 a.m., police received a dropped 911 call from a residence on Dudley Road. Further information was gathered that a number of individuals had entered the property and assaulted the complainant.

OPP arrived at the location along with Emergency Medical Services (EMS) where the victim was treated for non-life-threatening injuries and transported to a local hospital. Two males sought in connection to the incident were gone before police arrival. Among the items taken was some jewelry.

The scene was secured by officers as Forensic Identification Services (IDENT) and the Northumberland OPP Crime Unit attended to assist with the investigation.

BRIGHTON:

On December 8, 2024, at around 8:15 p.m., OPP responded to a report of fraud where the complainant advised a person entered their residence on Prince Edward Street in Brighton where the individual proceeded to demand money for work that was not completed nor requested.

Police located a person matching the description provided nearby and they were taken into custody. The accused was wanted in relation to a number of incidents regarding fraud and theft in Brighton, the first of which occurred in June 2023.

In May 2024, the individual was unlawfully in a dwelling and took Canadian currency under false pretenses. On two occasions in November 2024, the person wanted money for work which wasn't completed at each address. Two more incidents of fraud were reported to OPP on December 2, 2024, where the victim advised that, over the previous week, they were twice intimidated into providing money for work or services not wanted.

As a result, A 40 year old from the Municipality of Brighton, was held for bail to appear before the Ontario Court of Justice in Cobourg on the following charges:

- Theft over \$5,000
- Theft under \$5,000

- Unlawfully in a dwelling – two counts
- Failure to comply with undertaking
- Fraud under \$5,000 – four counts
- Fail to comply with release order – other than to attend court.

CRAMAHE:

On December 8th shortly after midnight, an officer received a call for a domestic disturbance in the Township of Cramahe. Through thorough investigation, it was revealed that the accused was impaired and had fled in a vehicle.

Officers set up a blockade on the 401 to intercept the accused's vehicle.

A 33 year old from Cramahe Township, has been charged with:

- Operation while impaired – blood alcohol concentration (80 plus)
- Operation while impaired – alcohol and drugs.
- Assault- Spousal

HAMILTON:

On December 8, 2024, shortly after 12:30 a.m., an officer was on patrol when they observed a pickup truck unable to maintain its lane as it was travelling westbound on Highway 401 in the Township of Hamilton.

The vehicle was stopped and following speaking to the driver, OPP entered into an impaired operation investigation and an Approved Screening Device (ASD) demand was made. The individual provided a sample of breath and with the result of 'Fail', the accused was taken into custody and transported to a local detachment for further tests.

A 33 year old from Oshawa, has been charged with:

- Operation while impaired – blood alcohol concentration (80 plus)
- Operation while impaired – alcohol and drugs.

In addition to future court dates for both the accused, a further 90-day Administrative Driver Licence Suspension (ADLS) and a seven-day vehicle impound was initiated as per statute.

PORT HOPE:

On December 9, 2024, at around 9:25 a.m., the Municipality of Port Hope Fire and Rescue Services and OPP responded to a report of a vehicle on fire in the area of 4th Line.

Emergency services arrived at the location and ascertained that there were no persons injured as a result of the fire.

Through investigation into the matter, the period leading up to and circumstances surrounding the incident, the fire was found to have started intentionally and as a result, one person was arrested nearby and transported to a local detachment. There were no injuries reported to police.

While at the detachment, the individual damaged property in the cell area.

As a result, a 47-year-old, from the Municipality of Port Hope, has been charged with:

- Arson – damage to property – two counts
- Threats – damage property
- Mischief over \$5,000 – two counts
- Dangerous operation
- Driving while under suspension
- Assault

TRENT HILLS:

On December 5, 2024, at around 12:30 a.m., police responded to a complaint regarding a suspected impaired driver in the area of Front Street North in Campbellford.

Officers arrived at the location and spoke with the driver of a pickup truck matching the description provided in the report. Officers entered into an impaired operation investigation which resulted in the accused being arrested and transported to a local detachment for further tests.

As a result, a 29 year old from the Municipality of Trent Hills, has been charged with:

- Operation while impaired – alcohol and drugs
- Operation while prohibited.

In addition to a future court date, a further three-day licence suspension and a 45-day vehicle impound was initiated.
