- Addressed right away.

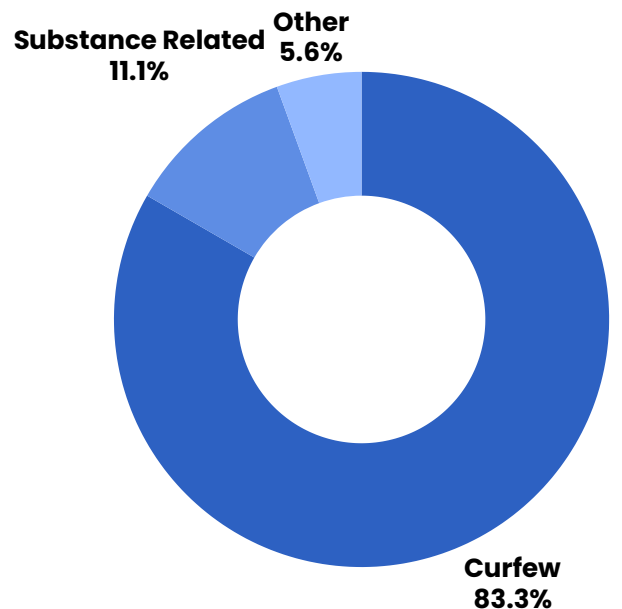
## Media:
